Identify ancillary grant documents, such as a W9 or IRS 501c3, as well as who to contact when you need to obtain them. Get tips on creating a compelling and persuasive grant narrative and one-on-one support as you begin writing. All participants will be asked to complete a rough draft of their narrative to send to the Facilitator prior to Workshop 3 ... where we put it all together!

Workshop 3.0 ~ Cooking up a Winner! March 24, 2018

Prior to attending Workshop 3, all participants will have sent their draft grant narrative to the Facilitator for review and suggestions. In Workshop 3, participants will put it all together! Finalize your grant narrative, complete your application package and submit your proposal!
